Ships are looking for persons with experience in the Hospitality Industry and or Prior Shipboard positions. Jobs not requiring customer interaction may fall within a wider range of Skill Sets and you may still apply, extended wait periods can be met until suitable positions become available!

It is advisable that you seek experience and training in the Hospitality Industry if you wish to take up Frontline Positions like Guest Services, Hotel, Food and Beverage or Entertainment.

We also wish to thank you for perusing our website as you might be considering a Cruise Ship Job! Please note and understand outlined points within this concise correspondence.

Working on a cruise ship is an exciting and unique opportunity that combines travel, adventure, and an extremely vibrant work environment. Before we set sail, let's delve into the essential aspects of life onboard a Majestic Cruise Vessel and what it entails to secure you as CREW!

Should you be chosen and upon Mutual Confirmation you will be given a **Letter of Intent (LOI)**. The Intended Crew Member will be asked to Fund and Undertake Extensive Medical Tests and Evaluation (s) to ensure that you are sound for a **SHIP JOB**. A candidate will also be asked to pass a **Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping** – **STCW** also to be funded by candidate. Some Cruise Lines have their own onboard **STCW** Training and may or may not incur costs. Note also that **Sea Farers VISAS** and other **VISAS** also incur costs to the Candidate and **ONLY** in **SOME CASES** and **DEPENDANT** on **Specific Cruise Line Policies** VISA costs

can be refunded. The Letter of Intent will outline all the necessary steps the Intended Crew must take in a Timely Manner! Intended Crew can be called at the drop of a hat to Set Sail.

Staff can work as much as 80 hours per week and Sunday to Sunday!
